The revised plan includes new hazards (*Thunderstorm, Lightning, Squall, Dust Storm, and Strong Wind / Cloudburst and Hailstorms / Glacial Lake Outburst Flood (GLOF) / Heat wave / Biological and Public Health Emergencies (BPHE) / Forest Fire*), new chapters (*Coherence and Mutual Reinforcement for DRR of the Post-2015 Global Frameworks / Social Inclusion / Mainstreaming DRR*) and also includes *Climate Change Risk Management* as new thematic area for climate risk informed DRR. 2. This NDMP has delineated time bound actions for all concerned Ministries/Departments/Agencies and other stakeholders in order to match it with timelines of Sendai Framework for DRR. So it is important that concerned Ministries and Departments and other stakeholders also develop their plans and strategies accordingly to match the timelines of NDMP 2019 to achieve the Sendai targets.

3. This information about the release of revised NDMP 2019 may kindly be widely circulated within your Ministry / Department so that all concerned start taking necessary actions, as envisaged in NDMP 2019.

4. It is mandated under section 37 (1) (a) (i) of the DM Act 2005 that every Ministry or Department of the Government of India shall prepare a disaster management plan specifying the measures to be taken by it for prevention and mitigation of disasters in accordance with the National Plan. You are requested to take steps to prepare / revise Disaster Management Plan of your Ministry / Department based on the National Disaster Management Plan 2019.
